SOME THINGS CAN'T BE LEGISLATED Leviticus 19:18

You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the sons of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself.

Leviticus 19:18 is the passage Jesus quoted when he noted a "second" command (Matthew 22:39). That command implies a lot in regard to how we treat one another. Jesus was talking about "agape" love, the kind of love that has to do with how we treat others. The parable of the Good Samaritan a great illustration of what it means to "agape" our neighbor. In one sense, then, "love" can be legislated.

On the other hand, there is one sense in which it cannot be. At some point, love is something that comes from the heart. In that sense, it cannot be coerced. Try as we might, we cannot force people to have certain things in their hearts.

We frequently read of horrific crimes being committed by people whose hearts are filled with hate and rage. As long as Satan dominates the hearts of men and women, horrible things are going to take place.

It is imperative that Christians be the light of the world that we show the world what Jesus is like. It is the love of Christ that attracts people to him. Just a few days before the cross, Jesus foretold His death. One of the things He said was "And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to Myself" (John 12:32). If you want to see people change their hearts, tell them about the love of Christ. Show them what it really means to follow Him. --**Ron Harper**-- Adapted from Chris Simpson

Exodus 32 has always thrown me for a loop. I have never been able to understand why the people of Israel acted in the way that they did. How could they doubt the one Supreme Being that led them out of Egypt? How could they doubt the one person who continually pleaded on behalf of these sinful people? But think about it in this way: If the President left to go meet with a ruler of another country and the nation didn't see or hear from him for 40 days, what would the result be? By that point, the Vice President would have taken over and he would be running the nation. I wonder if that is how Israel felt.

The people approached Aaron and asked him to make them a god because they did not know what had happened to Moses. Aaron was not hesitant. Rather, he gave them instructions (v. 2-3) and made a molten calf. Aaron, in verse 4 proclaims, "This is your god, oh Israel, who brought you up from the land of Egypt!"

We give Aaron a hard time. How could you be so ignorant?! Don't you know there is only one God?! However, we do the same thing all the time. It is interesting that in Exodus 32:4, Aaron took an **engraving tool** and fashioned the calf at the exact same time God was **engraving the law** onto the tablets (Exodus 31:18).

What graven images are we making in our lives? While we don't live under the Law of Moses, we do live under the Law of Christ. Are we serving earthly, graven images or the law of Christ?
