Is There A Need For God?

Recently, I was listening to a debate between Dan Barker, a leading authority for atheism, and Kyle Butt, a leading authority for apologetics. In his opening statement, Dan Barker made a comment that I wish to address in the few paragraphs that I have here. The statement was this: "There's no need for a belief in a god. You can live a really happy, joyful, wonderful, meaningful life without that religious baggage."

It is true. A person can live a happy, meaningful life without believing in God or even a god. People do it every day. Does that mean there is no **need** for God? Absolutely not! We do not believe in and worship God because it adds to the quality of our earthly lives, although that is a gift we receive (see Philippians 4:19; James 1:17; Matthew 6:30-33). We do not serve God for our care in this life but rather for our care in the next. Life is not easy with God. Remember, James tells us to consider it joy when we encounter trials (James 1:2).

So why do we need God? First, we cannot save ourselves. God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit offer salvation and forgiveness of sin (Acts 2; Ephesians 2; 1 Peter 3:21). This is something we cannot get anywhere else in the world! Second, without God, life has no meaning. Even atheists will admit they feel a sense of purpose and superiority to nature. That is because God allows us to rule over nature (Psalm 8) and our purpose is to serve him (Colossians 3:23-24). Lastly, although there are several other reasons we don't have the time to get into, we cannot live forever in glory with him if there is no need for God. Perhaps this is redundant since the atheist would say there is no Heaven. However, if we believe there is life after this, we need God to get there.

The truth is we simply need God. We need him for the care of our souls. This should make us all think about what condition our souls are in. If we are not willing and ready to meet the God we so desperately need, we need to make a change. We need God!
