REPENT Acts 2:38

Peter said to them, repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 2:38 is just one of a number of passages that commands repentance. Peter promised his audience forgiveness of sins if they would repent and be baptized. In Acts 8, in a different situation, a Christian sinned by trying to purchase the gift of God with money. Peter told Simon to "repent of this wickedness of yours, and pray the Lord that, if possible, the intention of your heart may be forgiven you" (Acts 8:22).

Repent means to change your mind or heart. It results in a change of direction. In both of these two biblical cases, people were involved in sin. In the first case, people who had never been saved were told to turn away from sin and unite with Christ in baptism. The second case involved a man who had been baptized but had slipped back into sin. He did not need to be baptized again but he did need to repent of his wickedness and pray for forgiveness.

The great thing about repentance is that, through it, God offers us a chance to turn away from sin. Sin separates us from God and destroys our lives. But it doesn't have to be the end of the story. God is more than willing to forgive us provided we are willing to turn away from sin. Through His grace, we are able to have a new life. That's about as positive as it gets. --*Ron Harper*--

"The flood continued forty days on the earth. The waters increased and bore up the ark, and it rose high above the earth. The waters prevailed and increased greatly on the earth, and the ark floated on the face of the waters. Genesis 7:17-20

Even though it is easy to complain about the rain, it is nothing in comparison to the flood of Noah. Even though the Earth was destroyed and only a few (in the grand scheme of the whole world) living beings were saved, let's look at the goodness of God in this story.

First, rain brings a renewal. God used the flood to wipe out the evil that existed in the world. The world was so corrupt that God regretted making the world in the first place. However, God saw the righteousness of Noah and chose to save him and his family. After the flood, there was the chance for a new beginning.

Second, the destruction of the world by water instigated God's promise that he would never again destroy the world in such a way. The sign of this promise can be seen in the rainbow every time it rains.

Lastly, just as the rain provided a clean slate for the world, God uses water as the avenue for our clean slate in baptism. As we are buried with Christ in baptism, we are raised having a clean slate as if our sins never happened. Rain, rain, it's okay if you stay.
