Revelation 4:11

Worthy are You, our Lord and our God, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things and because of Your will they existed and were created.

Many times in our life we become so concerned when blessings stop that we forget to see the new blessings that come. The people of Israel were about to receive what was promised. Do we trust God enough to know that even when one blessing ends, another will come?
