COURAGE Matthew 14:4

For John had been saying to him, "It is not lawful for you to have her."

Webster's New Collegiate Dictionary defines courage as "mental or moral strength to venture, persevere, and withstand danger, fear, or difficulty." That is a mouthful but it shows what John the Baptist clearly had. Courage enabled him to tell the truth to Herod Antipas. At the risk of his own life, John rebuked a ruler who had stolen his own brother's wife. The end result was that John lost his head.

Rejection and ridicule are intimidating things and Satan uses the fear of those to keep us from sharing the Good News with others. If John could confront a sinful ruler about his wicked lifestyle, surely I can speak to others about Jesus. All it takes is a little courage. We won't lose our heads but we just might lead someone to Jesus.
