A little later the bystanders came up and said to Peter, "Surely you too are one of them; for even the way you talk gives you away."

The bystanders may have been talking about Peter's accent when they said "the way you talk gives you away." In order to facilitate his denial, Peter immediately spoke in such a way as to deny any real connection to Jesus. "He began to curse and swear. . ." I don't know what that sounds like in Aramaic, the spoken language of Palestine in the time of Christ. I've heard it enough in English to easily recognize it when I hear it.

I wonder what people would say about the way I talk? What am I giving away? Am I known for my profanity? Do people avoid me because they know I am all too prone to give them the piece of my mind that would best be kept to myself?

Does the way I talk indicate that I am a great discourager? Or am I, like Barnabas, known as one who encourages others (Acts 4:36)? Am I known for honesty or do my words give me away as one who cannot be trusted?

Here is a truth that can benefit all of us. Our words really do matter. It was Jesus who said "for the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart" (Matthew 12:34). The way we talk gives us away. Let our prayer be that of the Psalmist. "Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my rock and my Redeemer" (Psalm 19:14).

Last Sunday, I received a call from my mother. She was driving herself to meet me here in Murfreesboro so I could take her to the Emergency Room due to a gallbladder attack. If you were at the worship service, you likely saw me bolt out like Dale Earnhardt from our parking lot. That was why.

My mother was in more pain than I have ever seen. I would never wish to see a human being bear this kind of load. My mother has an incredibly high pain tolerance and is the strongest person I know, yet she was doubled-over in pain. Finally, the doctors and nurses gave her medications for the attack and she began to feel somewhat better. Long story longer, that night at our evening service, many of you told me to "let you know if I needed anything." For once in my life, I knew those words carried weight.

You see, it is not what we say that makes us a Christian, but what we do. Jesus himself said, "By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another" (John 13:35). The love at Salem Creek is abundant. They are ripe and profitable because they are nourished by the living water of Jesus Christ. My prayer for our family here is that we never let our words lose their weight. Jesus said, "Let your 'yes' be 'yes' and your 'no' be 'no'" (Matthew 5:37). Our words carry weight only if our actions are there to back it up. I know that is true here. I admit this article is different from most that I write. I strongly felt the need to express my thanks for your love and service not only to me but to each other. I would like to sum up this article in two words: thank you.
