

SICK PEOPLE

Matthew 9:12

But when Jesus heard this, He said, "it is not those who are healthy who need a physician, but those who are sick."

"You need to see the doctor." I can't tell you how many times I've heard those words or said them to someone else. Far more often than not, they are spoken during a time of illness. Sick people need to see the doctor.

Jesus was criticized for "eating with the tax collectors and sinners" (Matthew 9:11). His response to that criticism is found in verse 12, "it's the sick people who need the doctor." Sin is the sickness and Jesus is the doctor. There are two points to be made.

I sin. Therefore, I need the Doctor. Jesus is the only one who has the solution for the disease. His blood is the cure and I need a transfusion. His blood will take away my sin, I can be cured. That's the good news we want to hear.

The second point is also important. To those who criticized Him, Jesus said "go and learn what this means: 'I desire compassion, and not sacrifice,' for I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners" (Matthew 9:13).

You do not criticize sick people for going to the doctor and you certainly do not criticize the doctor for taking care of the sick. In reality, we all have to deal with the same disease. It is often said that the church is like a hospital. That's true. Hospitals are places where sick people are welcome. We need to be sure that those who need to see Jesus are welcome among us. God help me to be less critical and more welcoming.
