Genesis 1:26

Then God said, "Let us make man in Our image, according to our likeness."

If you are one of those who thinks "I don't want a God who _____ (fill in the blank with whatever part of God's character you wish to deny), I urge you to consider this. **He** is the creator, you are the creature. I do not have the right to remake God in my image. Or, as Paul put it in Romans 9:20, "who are you, O man, who answers back to God? You know you are a sinner, you've been told you are a sinner, and you have attempted to no longer be a sinner. But what if I told you that you are evil? That has a different ring to it. If God is good because he is sinless then I am evil because I have sin. How comfortable and complacent have we gotten with being evil? The fact is many of us simply do not care.

Peter admonishes the persecuted church to grow in two areas—grace and knowledge. Some of us are so consumed with grace that we have forgotten to learn the reason that grace exists. Other of us are so consumed with the intricate details of the Bible that we have forgotten the overall theme from Genesis to Revelation. The command here is to grow. We cannot grow if we are complacent in our own status with Christ or lack thereof.

The attitude that we know everything will be our downfall. We must humbly and sincerely search the scriptures to learn and understand the grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ.
