Torpedoes that Sink Our Fellowship Part 3: Gossip

"Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear." Ecclesiastes 4:29

As a kid growing up in a small country church, we never had a real "youth group." That being said, several of the teens would get together and have devotionals and fellowship with each other from time to time. As most teens do, we also loved playing various games. One of our favorites to play was called "Telephone." The game goes something like this: first, one person whispers a word or a sentence to the person sitting beside him or her. The whisper must be discrete and so silent that the second person will only hear it if he or she is truly listening. No one else can hear it. Second, that person whispers the word or phrase to the next person and so on it goes until the word or phrase reaches the last person. Once the last person has the phrase, he or she must say what they heard aloud. Most of the time, the phrase is completely different or inaudible by the time it reaches the last person. For example, "I saw a bee" could turn into "I paw a tree." The point is that what was said can and will become twisted and will be misinterpreted somewhere down the line.

The same is true with rumors and gossip. There are two blessings that stem from the lips God gave us: the blessing to open them and speak as well as the blessing to keep our mouths shut. Gossip has only one purpose—to tear down. Gossip is more than repeating a sentence. It is the spreading of false or negative information. Perhaps sometimes that information needs to be given to someone, but for an instructive or corrective purpose, not to slander.

Thumper (from the movie *Bambi*) said it best. "If you can't say something nice, don't say anything at all." Words are powerful. They can lift us up or tear us apart. Empty and angry words are just that...empty and angry. These words cause strife and strife causes tension. Tension, when stretched enough, will snap, breaking our fellowship. But love strengthens, love heals, love builds. Let's love and grow.


