The week spent in Nicaragua was an unbelievable experience. Thanks to all who helped make this trip a reality. Your financial support, prayers, and cards were a blessing.

Our work began on Saturday with the annual ladies conference attended by 300 people. Our own Janie Harper was one of the speakers and, in addition, our group provided child care during the conference. On Saturday afternoon we walked through the neighborhood handing out flyers inviting people to Bible School.

We had a great morning in worship with our Nicaraguan brethren on Sunday and praise God for a baptism that took place after worship. On Sunday afternoon we began Bible school with a total attendance of 272. For the next three afternoons we had well over 400 each day.

This year our group painted a couple of murals on the outside walls of one of the buildings at Nicaragua Christian School. It was dedicated to the memory of Mary Jo Rogers. On Monday morning we paid a visit to a school for children with "special needs." We were able to deliver to the school a number of coloring books, cleaning supplies, and medical supplies.

We thank God for the experience and pray that next year's trip will also be a great success. The praise belongs to Him.

Numbers have been down. Discouragement has been up. Your congregation started years ago and had initial growth, but now everything seems stagnant. Everyone seems happy to be there, but if anything, it is a front. In reality, people are asking, "What is the point?" In the Bible, we read of a church that grew. This was the church that God built. This is the church God wants us to be. If we follow its pattern, then our churches will be in the right mindset for growth.

Growing Churches Worship (Acts 2:42-43)

Worship is vital towards our relationship with God. Without it we have no relationship. "Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire" (Heb. 12:28). Think about how huge that is. We have the opportunity to come before the God who created everything and offer worship to Him. (Notice how the passage says acceptable worship.) *Growing Churches Serve* (Acts 2:44-45)

When was the last time you really served someone? Jesus makes it clear that on judgment day, whether or not we have served on this earth will determine if we go to Heaven or Hell (Matt. 25:31-46). Serving is not easy to put into practice because it requires us to put others before ourselves (Phil. 2:3-5). The book of James teaches us that true Christianity involves service and helping those in need.

In Acts 2:44, the Bible says Christians were selling their possessions and giving to those who were in need. That is love. When the world sees the church that Jesus sacrificed for, they need to see a church that sacrifices.

Growing Churches Fellowship (Acts 2:46)

Have you ever wondered why God requires us to come together as a church to worship Him? Could we not worship alone in our homes? The reason God designed the church the way he did was so it could be one body, perfectly joined together (1 Cor. 1:10). We come together so we can lift one another up. Whether we are in times of sadness, struggle or gladness, we have each other (Gal. 6:1-2).
