Governor Agricola of Armenia tried to carry this out but was faced with 40 Christian soldiers who refused to obey and betray their faith. He had them whipped, pierced with iron hooks, and chained in dungeons all to no avail. Finally he directed that they be stripped of their clothing and driven out on an ice pond until they obeyed. History records they removed their own clothing and ran onto the ice singing hymns. The governor had fires and hot baths set up on the sides to temp them. Only one gave up but died as soon as he got into the hot water. One of the guards is supposed to have been so impressed that he removed his clothing and replaced the dead man. What a magnificent display of faith that speaks to us across the years.

As Americans we are blessed with the freedom to worship as God has commanded. I admit that I take this blessing for granted as I have never been subject to persecution because of my religious beliefs. Oh I have had people challenge certain beliefs; but, never have I been faced with punishment or death for following God's word.
