# AN APPOINTMENT TO KEEP

And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once and after this comes judgment, so Christ also, having been once offered to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time for salvation without reference to sin, to those who eagerly await Him.

Hebrews 9:27

How certain is it that Jesus will appear a second time? It is just as certain as death itself. To make that point the writer referred to a simple fact of life, "it is appointed for men to die once." In other words, we are all going to die. The only exceptions would be those who are alive at the time Christ returns (1 Thessalonians 4:13).
