THOUGHTS ON PRAYER 1 Thessalonians 5:17 "Pray without ceasing"

Weight lifting is an Olympic sport that I find it both entertaining and educational. It is impressive to see people lift weights far in excess of their body weight. When you watch them, you can be sure of this, that moment is not the first time they have attempted to lift that weight. They have been in the gym for hours on end, training and lifting. When the time comes, they meet the challenge. They do not start the process when they walk out on stage in the Olympics. They have already prepared themselves for the test.

So it is with prayer and spiritual strength. Jesus went to the Garden to pray, He was about to face the most decisive crisis in human history. Would He go to the cross or would He call for the angels to deliver Him? He went to the Garden to pray. After a while, He returned to His friends to find them sleeping.

He roused them from their sleep and said "keep watching and praying that you may not enter into temptation" (Matthew 26:41). They ignored Jesus and continued their nap. Shortly, our Lord answered the greatest challenge of the ages. As for His friends, they fell flat on their spiritual faces. Unlike the Olympic weight lifter and totally unlike Jesus, they failed to prepare themselves. Our strength to face the temptations and challenges of life will always be in direct proportion to the preparation we have made through prayer. That makes those three words very urgent. "Pray without ceasing."

Light the Fire

"For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline." 2 *Timothy* 1:7

It's a scary world out there. Just last week, we heard of a congregation of God's people being terrorized by a gunman whose only goal was to harm people. It is no wonder Christians are apprehensive to evangelize in their own communities. Times have changed. We cannot simply knock on doors without fear of being threatened. There are two opposing realities within our world: the reality that sin is rampant and the reality that the gospel must be spread.

I do not think it is accidental that Jesus sent his own evangelism parties out in groups of two. Luke 10:1 tells us that Jesus appointed seventy people to go ahead of him in cities and tell people about him. These seventy people were sent out in pairs. Why? It's simple. One man cannot do it all. However, Jesus did not sugarcoat the task at hand. It would be challenging, people would not accept them or their message but they were to keep speaking about Jesus no matter the cost.

Peter and John when beaten by the Sanhedrin in Acts 4:20 boldly stated, "we cannot stop speaking about what we have seen and heard." Don't misunderstand me, I know none of us have seen or heard Jesus in a concrete way (i.e. a face to face encounter). Even so, one of the most powerful ways to spread the word of God is to tell people what God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit have done for us in our own lives. That's exactly what Paul did. Why should we be any different?

We have a message. We have a purpose. We have a command to obey. We have a God to serve. We cannot do it alone! Until we as a congregation get excited and on fire for the Lord, no progress will be made in our community. It's time to light the fire in our hearts again!
