# **KEEP CHRIST IN CHRISTMAS?**

Acts 2:42 tell us, "And they were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and prayer." Acts 20: 7 tells us that Paul spoke to Christians at Troas on the first day of the week when they were assembled to break bread (observe the Lord's Supper). These things we are commanded to do. By taking the Lord's Supper we remember His death until He comes again. In honoring His death we acknowledge His birth as you can't have a death if there has not first been a birth. The bible has many warnings about adding to the things God saw fit to bind on His children.

As we go through this holiday season, I urge you to be careful in your celebrations while still enjoying this family time. Many people outside the Church are more receptive during the holidays and if you get an opportunity to more accurately teach someone the scriptures, take advantage of it. Keep Christ in Christmas? It is impossible to keep something in that was never there to begin with!
